
To summarise into one document the proposal for road/pavement changes in Wixams to allow for BBC Highways to carry out a single consultation:

Proposal:

1. “No parking on verge or footway” signs. BBC Highways created a proposal in May 2019 (DRG C900.C682) at the parish council’s request for restrictions along Brooklands Avenue. This section was much shorter than the parish council had anticipated; council requested to lengthen the included area along Brooklands Avenue and also to include Green Lane and Bedford Road.


ACTION: Requires BBC Highways to produce new proposal for agreement before the consultation period

2. Bollards on corner of Kingfisher Road and Brooklands Avenue to protect pedestrians, at request of parishioner. Also require double yellows to stop inconsiderate/unsafe parking on that corner.

3. There is currently no path between the pavement and bus stop on Bedford Road, forcing pedestrians to use the road or slip on the grass. Request a pavement to be constructed to link the bus stop and pavement.

4. A Pelican crossing on Green Lane for schoolchildren, due to the expansion of the schools and increased traffic in Wixams due to development.
ACTION: Requires BBC Highways to produce a proposal/location for agreement before the consultation period.
5. Request from Retirement Home residents and owner to add a bus shelter at the bus stop Cllr Coombes is taking this forward. Has Parish Council support.



6. Southern Cross:
Cars park alongside the road where Southern Cross bends, as it goes into village 2, just after Swift Way, which makes it difficult for large vans (mainly removal vans) to get past. We saw one vehicle struggling with this spot when we were there.
Proposal: Either yellow lines or bay parking and traffic calming (speed hump) where the road bends
7. Brooklands Avenue (1):
Parking on the 'S' bend between Bittern Lane and Knoll Gardens, making it difficult for traffic to get through. This is also a bus route, and traffic often meets head on and one vehicle has to reverse
Proposal: yellow lines along the 'S' bend area of Brooklands
8. Brooklands Avenue (2):
Parking on pavements between Piper lane, Wren Terrace and Little Owl Lane
Proposal: no parking on footways signs along the section of Brooklands Avenue and no parking around the junctions of each of the roads mentioned.

9. Green Lane/Harrier Leys:

Traffic to/from the MUGA not stopping at the junction of Green lane and Harrier Leys. Also parking along Green lane where the road bends, making it difficult for cars to get past and particularly bad when 2-way traffic

Proposal: Yellow lines along the bend of Green Lane (opposite Eagle Mews) up to the junction with Harrier Leys

10. Bedford Road:

Kerb parking along the pavement near Falcon Field which restricts the ability of residents opposite to access their drives and frequent grass verge parking on the area between Swan Road and Magpie Gardens (opposite Seasons Garden Centre).

Proposal: "no verge parking" and "no kerb parking" roundels on the lamp columns along Bedford Road

11. Bedford Road/Retirement village

Parking restrictions (yellow lines) requested to stop large vehicles ruining the grass verges.
