Wixams Parish Council News

Benches

The nine new benches have been delivered to our contractor and will be installed when we have a period of drier weather - installing them now would cause too much damage to the grass. To remind you, these will be installed at various locations all across Wixams. The plans are available upon request.

Speed feedback signs

The four vehicle-activated speed feedback signs have been delivered and their columns should have been installed by the time you read this. The locations are on Green Lane, Southern Cross, Bedford Road and Brooklands Avenue. These flash up vehicle speeds to encourage safer driving.

Facebook group

The parish council will shortly be creating a Facebook group for the purposes of sharing information from the parish council. We will advertise this group when it's ready. Correspondence with the parish council from residents should remain via email/letter/phone call directly to the clerk.

Village 2 noticeboard

A noticeboard for the parish council and the public is planned to be installed soon at the new "centre" of Village 2 - by the roundabout on Harlequin Crescent. The parish council understands from Barratt Homes that this area, currently in the final stages of development, is shortly to be opened to the public.

Village 3 consultation

The parish council has been asked for comment on the Design Brief for Village 3; this was discussed at October's parish council meeting. Concerns have been raised over material differences between the original plan and the current planned design. The parish council hopes to work with the borough council planners and the developer to understand this "gap" in the plans.

Councillor Vacancies

The parish council has received a pleasing level of interest in the two councillor vacancies and hopes to fill the positions at the November meeting. Please contact the clerk if you are interested, as the process is ongoing.

Wixams Streetwatch

Wixams now has 5 Streetwatch volunteers, and needs 3 more to start

At present there are 18 Streetwatch schemes across the county covering areas such as Biggleswade, Luton and Houghton Regis with many being concentrated in the Central part of the county.

Streetwatch is about helping keep your community safe by patrolling in pairs for two hours a month. Patrols are logged with our force contact centre.

All members are covered by Public Liability Insurance and Personal Accident and Injury Cover.

All volunteers are issued with a high visibility Streetwatch vest, personal attack alarm, torch, pocket note book for recording activity and pens.

Induction patrols are then carried out with members of the local policing team.

All volunteers will be offered first aid training and also Conflict Management Training.

Our Streetwatch groups work

closely with their local policing team by promoting effective communication and the prompt reporting of activity.

Patrols will be tasked in areas where there has been crime reported or where there have

been instances of anti-social behaviour.

Your presence alone provides valuable reassurance to your community especially the vulnerable and the elderly. Streetwatch

volunteers engage in local issues that matter

most to the communities in which they live and this has a significant and positive impact within your community and helps to reduce crime.

Streetwatch when working alongside Neighbourhood Watch can have a significant effect on the levels of anti-social behaviour.





Reporting to Wixams (November 2020)

A big issue since September has been parking and congestion on the school run along Green Lane and nearby roads. I've received much correspondence, both from local residents, as well as from the schools themselves.

The traffic problem poses a real threat to the safety of children on their journey to school, as well as being a constant nuisance for those living in the vicinity. Therefore this is not just a school problem, it's a traffic problem for local residents too as they are frequently having driveways blocked and difficulty getting out to work through the morning travel chaos, as traffic often tails back past the T-junction with Bedford Road.

I attended a meeting on 8th October with both school Heads and School Transport Officers from the Borough Council and discussed a number of options for trying to resolve this.

One option is to look at creating a "School Street" and I have written to the Deputy

Mayor, responsible for Transport, expressing support for considering this option, though making clear any solution has to involve consultation with residents in Green Lane and the streets around it. An Emergency TRO (Traffic Regulation Order) is another option.

Ongoing work is being done by the schools and Borough Transport Officers, to make the roads safe for children and remove the congestion and bad parking from outside people's homes.

There is unlikely to be any quick fix to this, as we are looking at behavioural change being required by parents currently driving their children to school. If you are a Wixams parent and you still drive your child to school, please do your bit to help, by walking rather than taking the car.

Grants



Councillor Tim Hill's Report

Tim is currently the Borough Councillor for Elstow, Stewartby, The Wixams Retirement Village and Kempston Hardwick

Much needed road works

Tim is really pleased to report what will hopefully be some good news. Following his work with Mayor Dave on this issue, it is now planned that resurfacing works to The Causeway and the A6 approaches to the Wixams Southern Cross, Causeway and Wilstead Road Elstow roundabouts will be done in this year's capital resurfacing programme. The design is currently underway and the works will be programmed to be completed during February and March 2021. Unfortunately the work cannot be brought forward any further due to seasonal restrictions in laying asphalt overnight. The planned works will also include provision of a new zebra crossing on Bedford Road, subject to consultation, to help improve the safety of pedestrian routes from the Retirement Village into Wixams.

Tim's Councillor's Ward Fund for 2020-21

Tim has made a £800 contribution towards the cost of purchasing and installing two benches near the Wixams Retirement Village

Interchange congestion

It is sadly inevitable that with such a major change in the layout of the Interchange, designed and paid for by its landowner, serious vehicle congestion on the site would occur. 
