NHS SAID 'NO' TO A WIXAMS DOCTOR'S SURGERY

Write/email today - change their minds!

Over 1,000 residents responded to the Wixams Newsletter survey on the need for a Wixams GP (see March edition). Here are comments representing the 1,000 people on why NO WIXAMS GP is unacceptable.

£42 on taxi to go to doctors independently last week" as I'm registered blind"

"I can't get to Ampthill

"There is no public transport to Ampthill, Shortstown or Wootton, the nearest GPs"

"they will not do home visits due to the distance"

"I can't drive and I can't get to my GP by bus ... my baby son needs many drs appts due to his health needs."

"Currently I have to take 2 buses to get to the surgery. A visit takes about 4 hours. I'm severely sight impaired and have early stage dementia^t

"It was a nightmare when I was heavily pregnant"

"I don't drive so getting over to Wootton or Ampthill is too much"

"If my husband had been able to get a Drs appt his cancer may have been diagnosed sooner ... More people will die unnecessarily"

I going through Cancer treatment at the moment ... I can't take a bus. We really need a surgery here and I'm positive that I'm not the only one.

"healthcare authority needs to step up and prove that they put patient care first as is their mandate"

"we MUST have a GP"

"I don't drive"

"I have multiple health issue's and a young son, I can't drive due to the vast amount of medication I'm on, so I find it extremely hard or expensive in a taxi to get there as my mobility is impaired"



"I have 2 disabled (wheelchair -bound) boys and it is really hard ... When my boys are ill this is a long and exhausting journey [by bus]"

> "Having to drive to a surgery when you are unwell is horrible"

"it makes me avoid going to see the doctor"

"abhorrent way to treat young families"

"crazy" "outrageous" "disgrace" "shame on you"

"ICB – you have had 20+years to plan a surgery"

Following an intra-Parish Council meeting with Wilstead, Wixams, Houghton Conquest and Cotton End arranged by Wixams Parish Councillor Saqhib Ali, two meetings were subsequently held with the Mayor and planners from Bedford Borough and Central Bedfordshire.

At the Wixams Residents Association Meeting held on Wednesday 12 April 2023 Borough Cllr Graeme Coombes and District Cllr Rebecca Hares provided the following updates:

GP Surgery - Wixams Town Centre

After discussions with the Borough it looks as though:

- there is currently an £800k shortfall in funding for the building
- any healthcare centre building would be smaller than originally envisaged
- there would be some kind of 5 year leasing option in place for the BLMK to take it on

Cllr Coombes has had a strong indication from a Primary Care Provider in Ampthill that they would be willing to open an additional surgery at Wixams if and when the ICB agree to the new facility. The ICB fund GP providers.

The ICB are still maintaining that they cannot pay for the £190k annual running costs shortfall, which is absurd, as there is no other organisation whose responsibility this falls under, other than the ICB.

Both Councillors encouraged all residents to make their feelings known publicly by:

- Continue to lobby whoever is elected as Mayor and Ward Councillors after
 4 May

WANT TO START YOGA?

START BY BENDING OVER AND PICKING UP YOUR



THEN PUT IT IN THE BIN

The stark fact is that only about 60% of dog owners pick up after their dogs; 40% do not. This seems to hold true with some exceptions on the type of area according to studies done in parks, in urban communities, and in suburban areas. Sadly a lot of dog owners in Wixams choose NOT to clean after their pets.

40% of dog owners say that they don't pick up their pet's poop for a variety of reasons. The main being: They think it will eventually dissolve, decompose or otherwise go away.

Why is it important to pick up dog poop?

Picking it up promptly — Prevent parasites, bacteria, and viruses from infecting people or other pets by picking up your dog's poop immediately. Many parasites require days to weeks to reach the infective stage, so faeces becomes more hazardous to your health the longer it sits.

Here are some tips for effectively convincing your neighbour to pick up after their dog:

Try a Friendly Chat. If you've noticed your neighbour being slightly "forgetful" about bringing out the baggies, and other people are left to clean up after dog waste, try a friendly chat. Mention that you've noticed the issue and it's bothering you. Keep calm and keep it friendly.

The law allows our Environmental Crime Enforcement Officers to give anyone seen not clearing up after their dog an on-the-spot fine called a fixed penalty notice (FPN). The FPN is for $\pounds 50$, but if you are prosecuted in court for dog fouling you could receive a maximum fine of $\pounds 1,000$.

Cooking time: 20 minutes Difficulty: Easy Makes: 12 deep cupcakes

Ingredients

- I50g pot natural yogurt
- 3 eggs, beaten
- I tsp vanilla extract
- 175g golden caster sugar
- 140g self-raising flour (swap 1 tbsp of flour for cocoa powder)
- 100g ground almond
- 175g unsalted butter, melted

Chocolate Frosting

- 100g chocolate (milk or dark)
- 140g unsalted butter
- · 140g icing sugar

Father's Day Cup Cakes

For Fathers Day, why not treat your loved one by baking some cupcakes. You can make them really chocolatey or make them extra special by adding their favourite sweet or nut on top.

STEP |

Line a 12-hole muffin tin with paper cases and heat oven to 190C/fan 170C/gas 5. In a jug, mix the yogurt, eggs and vanilla extract. Put the dry ingredients, plus a pinch of salt, into a large bowl and make a well in the middle.

STEP 2

Add the yogurty mix and melted butter, and quickly fold in with a spatula or metal spoon – don't overwork it. Spoon into the cases (they will be quite full) and bake for 18-20 mins or until golden, risen and springy to the touch. Cool for a few mins, then lift the cakes onto a wire rack to cool



completely. Keep in an airtight container for up to 3 days or freeze as soon as possible

STEP 3

Chocolate frosting: Melt the chocolate in the microwave on High for 1½ mins, stirring halfway. Leave to cool. Beat the butter and icing sugar in a large bowl until creamy. Beat in the chocolate.

Cover and chill (for up to one month). Up to 48 hrs before serving (or the day before if it's really hot), bring back to room temperature, then spread over the cakes.

To finish the cupcake off, why not add a sweet treat. Put chocolate buttons on or any other sweet or nut on the top.

Keep cool, out of direct sunlight.



Mental Health Awareness Week 2023

Mental Health Awareness Week 2023 is focussing on anxiety to help raise awareness of what Anxiety is and providing information on what can help reduce it.

Anxiety is a feeling of unease, such as worry or fear that can be mild or severe. Anxiety can affect people in lots of different ways.

Occasional Anxiety is a normal part of life and some of us will worry about things such as health, money, or work or family problems. However, for many people anxiety can involve more than temporary worry or fear. In these cases anxiety does not go away, it can gradually get worse over time and for many the symptoms can interfere with daily activities such as job performance, schoolwork, and relationships.

The NHS website (www.nhs.uk) highlights that anxiety is the main symptom of several conditions including:

- · panic disorder
- phobias, such as agoraphobia or claustrophobia
- post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD)
- · social anxiety disorder (social phobia)

Over the next few editions of the Wixams Newsletter, we will be providing a series of information on national and local resources on areas of anxiety.

Effects of anxiety on your body

People with anxiety will experience effects in different ways. Some of the effects anxiety can have on your body include:

- · a churning feeling in your stomach
- sweating or hot flushes
- · feeling light-headed or dizzy
- sleep problems
- · pins and needles
- · grinding your teeth, especially at night
- · feeling restless or unable to sit still
- nausea (feeling sick)
- · headaches, backache or other aches and pains
- · needing the toilet more or less often
- faster breathing
- changes in your sex drive
- a fast, thumping or irregular heartbeat
- having panic attacks

Ways in which you can look after yourself

- Talk about how you're feeling and what's making you anxious. Just being heard and understood may make you feel better. You could open up to a friend or call Anxiety UK's helpline.
- Look after your physical health. Physical activity is a great way to keep you physically healthy as well as improving your mental wellbeing. Even a short burst of 10 minutes brisk walking can improve your mental alertness, energy and mood. This could also include gardening, cycling, community activities
- Eating well can improve your wellbeing and your mood. A balance diet is one that includes healthy amounts of proteins, essential fats, complex carbohydrates, vitamins, minerals and water.

Effects of anxiety on your mind

People with anxiety will experience effects in different ways. Some of the effects anxiety can have on your mind include:

- feeling tense, nervous or unable to relax
- low mood and depression
- · having a sense of dread, or fearing the worst
- rumination thinking a lot about bad experiences, or thinking over a situation again and again
- feeling like other people can see you're anxious and are looking at you
- depersonalisation a type of dissociation where you feel disconnected from your mind or body, or like you are a character that you are watching in a film
- feeling like you can't stop worrying, or that bad things will happen if you stop worrying
- derealisation another type of dissociation where you feel disconnected from the world around you, or like the world isn't real
- worrying about anxiety itself, for example worrying about when panic attacks might happen
- worrying a lot about things that might happen in the future – you can read more about these sorts of worries on the Anxiety UK website.
- wanting lots of reassurance from other people or worrying that people are angry or upset with you
- Avoid smoking and drinking alcohol. Many people with mental health problems believe that smoking relieves their symptoms, but these effects are only short-term.
- Get enough sleep. Establish a regular, relaxing bedtime routine that lets you unwind and sends a signal to your brain that it's time to sleep
- **Breathing exercises.** Practising mindfulness may be useful for some people.

Here are some statistics to give you some insight on how many people across the UK are affected by anxiety.

In the UK, a little over 1 in 10 of us will be living with an anxiety disorder at any one time. That's over 8 million people.

MENTAL HEALTH UK

In any given week in England, 6 in 100 people will be diagnosed with General anxiety disorder.

MIND

An estimated 822,000 workers are affected by work-related stress, depression or anxiety every year.

HEALTH & SAFETY EXECUTIVE

Less than 50% of people with generalised anxiety disorder access treatment.

MENTAL HEALTH FOUNDATION

Over the next few editions of the Wixams Newsletter, we will be providing a series of information on national and local resources on areas of anxiety. To start you off here's just a couple of groups available in Wixams that can help.

Wilstead & Wixams Good Neighbours Scheme

Good neighbour groups are made up of local people who want to offer help and support to others in their community. We have a lot of vulnerable people in our two villages and with the group we can get direct help to those in need from one or our DBS checked volunteers. One particular concern is loneliness which can make people very isolated from the rest of society and can lead to them having further mental health issues such as anxiety and depression. To help with loneliness we offer a 'befriending' service where a volunteer can meet with a resident, at their home or somewhere public, for just a chat. We're not counsellors, we can't provide specific mental health support, but we can lend an ear and that can really make a difference.

Wixams Walkers

Did you know Wixams has a walking group? We're part of the national Wellbeing Walks scheme run by the Ramblers Association and we pride ourselves on being there for people in our community. Our walks are easy and accessible, last less than an hour and at a steady pace to suit everyone. If you're struggling with anxieties you might be surprised how our group can help. Everyone knows that getting exercise can help to improve your mental health, but it's the community that comes as part of the walking group itself which can give the biggest boost to your moral. We have a lovely bunch of regulars who are full of smiles and are very welcoming to new members, that can make a massive difference to people and has led to lots of new friendships being created in our town.

So why not give it a try?

We meet at 11am on Bedford Road outside of Seasons garden centre, well behaved dogs are also welcome!



May Garden Update by Deirdre Wilcock

It has been a little cooler than I would like for this time of year but the long range forecast for May is looking great so let's make the most of it! The garden has well and truly woken up from Winter. The trees are back in leaf and the garden is gearing up for summer! As the spring flowers die back for another year there may be a little gap before your summer flowers make an appearance, this is when summer flowers and super easy to take care of. Your local garden centres and supermarkets will stock a range of summer bedding plants that are ready to go and be planted. It has been known to still have overnight frosts in May so do keep an eye on the weather but by mid-May we shouldn't see any frosts again until later in the year. I have been super lucky this year and have tickets for the RHS Chelsea Flower Show later this month. Hope you have fun if you are going too!



Weeds love the month of May. It is warm and the ground is still a little wet so it is prime growing conditions for weeds. Keep the garden clear and tidy to avoid harbouring and pests. Regularly hoe bare ground to stop weeds germinating. May is the easiest month to kill off any weeds. If you have any bare soil in the garden I would strongly suggest covering the area with a thick mulch/bark to suppress any weeds that may grow.

Climbers

Climbing plants such as Clematis, Honeysuckle, Jasmine and Roses will be very active this month. Regularly check your climbers and tie in any new growth. If you are training a climber up a wall or arch or something similar it will need help in attaching itself to the structure. Keep the climber in check and ensure it's growing where you want it too, some climbers are quite vigorous growers and need to be kept in check. If you have a Clematis Montana, prune it after it has flowered. You can prune back as far as you need to, to keep it in it's allotted space or just give it a little tidy up.

Lawns

Lawns will be actively growing from now all through summer and into autumn. To maintain a heavy lawn it needs to have a good lawn maintenance program. Make sure the grass is cut at least once a week and not left long. Ensure weeds are removed promptly to avoid them going to seed and creating hundreds more, give it a good feed and sit back and enjoy!

Additional tasks for May

- Continue to deadhead spring bulbs and leave the foliage to due back naturally for next year's flowers and also give them a feed
- Regularly water any new plants that have been planted in the garden until they are well established
- Harden off any tender plants before planting out in the garden
- Stake and tie in perennials that require it before they become too well established
- Take cuttings from herbaceous perennials
- Water and feed all containers regularly
- Plant up hanging baskets
- Protect young plants from slugs and snails
- Plant out Dahlias towards the end of the month















